**EXHIBITORS:** In an effort to keep the show running on time and to get all qualifying classes in each day, we will have to abide by the early entry deadlines. ### **Pre-Entry Discounts for all Classes:**

This year in order to qualify for Pre-Entry class discounts, each horse must be pre-entered in their respective classes for the entire show and pre-paid before Oct.1\$, 2010. You may enter more classes at the show but not at the discount price and no credits will be issued for scratches or no shows without a valid excuse by a recognized Veterinarian.

### **2010 Spotted Mountain Horse entry changes**

This year **all** classes are **Open** to registered and certified Spotted Mountain Horses for the entire IGC Show. One exception is that the Spotted Mountain Horses will have their own Championship classes in each division Country Trail, Trail, Classic and Park. The reason for the Spotted Championships being set out separately is that the Champion Spotted Mountain horses that win first place in each division stated above will be recognized by **Title**, as the Spotted Champion representing the breed for 2010. These SMHA Championship classes will qualify each horse to go on to compete in the Grand Championship classes which are **Open** to both SMHA and KMSHA horses.

### **"FIRST SOLO" Pre-Juvenile Class:** (ANY BREED HORSE/PONY)

Front side of ring-straight a way-used only. This is a class for pre-juvenile solo riders who feel that they are above a lead line class but are not ready to show alone. Any horse or pony is okay, does not need to be gaited. Each rider should enter the ring and be accompanied by an adult who may help as needed (the adult does not lead the horse, the rider is in control). The rider enters the ring at a WALK, will be asked to reverse, WALK the other way of the ring and then will be called to the line up. The adult will stand by the rider and the Judge will address each rider.

**Pre-Entry Stalls:** \$125 each Wed 12 PM -Sun 9 AM (After 9 AM Sun. a \$50 penalty will apply by the KHP)

Stalls after Oct.1\$; \$150 each.

**Show Out of Trailers:** \$25 per horse per day, plus KHP daily trailer pass.

### **Entries and Cancellations must be made 3 classes ahead.**

Three or fewer entries- Result in paybacks that start with 2nd place money. Show Management may choose to cancel any class with only one entry.

**KMSHA/SMHA Open Classes** are open to horses of any sex or age Registered/Certified with the Kentucky Mountain Saddle or the Spotted Mountain Horse Associations and to any riders other than juvenile except in the case where the juvenile has been declared an adult rider as provided in the rulebook.

**Championship Classes:** In order to compete, a horse must have been shown in a qualifying class in a division addressed by the Championship class. Likewise for a Grand Championship Class.

**Conformation Classes** are not considered qualifying classes for under saddle Championship classes and vice-versa.

**Important Information:** All horses on show grounds must have a current Coggins and Health Certificate.

Persons on federal or certified HIO suspensions or disqualifications may not transport a horse to the show grounds and may not participate in the show in any way other than as a spectator.

**A 2010 KMSHA/SMHA exhibitor** must be a current member in good standing as defined in the rulebook, possess a current Riders Card and be able to present documentation showing that their horse is registered and certified with the KMSHA or SMHA.

**Rules/Regulations:** as outlined in the 2009-2010 KMSHA/SMHA Rulebook.

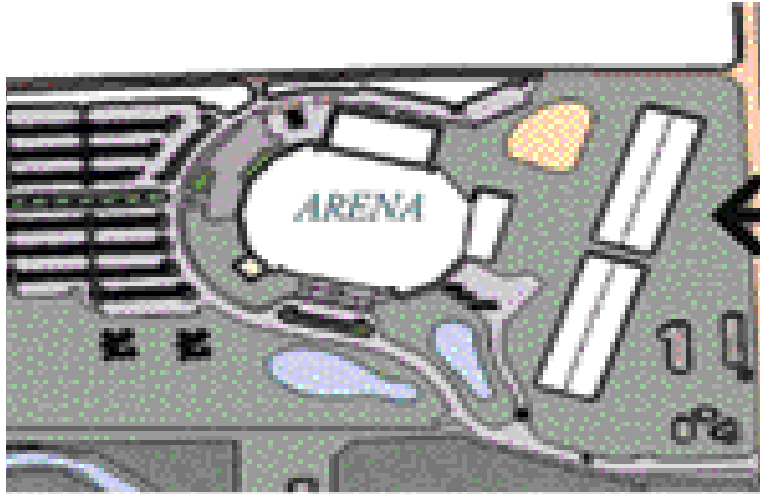

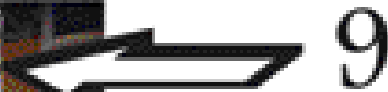

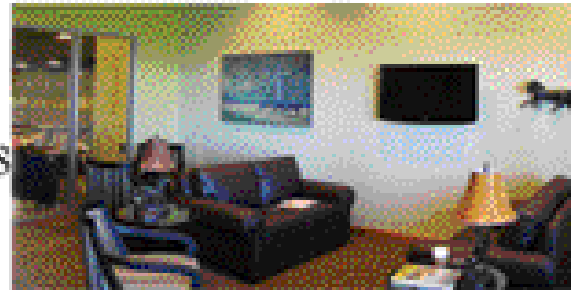

# KMSHA International Grand Championship Versatility Awards

*Exhibitor's wishing to be considered for any of the versatility awards must complete the Versatility Sign Up Sheet and turn it in to the show office prior to their first class needed for eligibility for their award.*

## Requirements for Eligibility (All Awards)

1. Exhibitor must declare horses/classes/riders prior to the start of the show Thursday morning by filling out the sign up sheet.
2. ALL classes must be declared for eligibility.
3. Unless otherwise specified in the awards below, Championship and Grand Championship classes do not count for points.
4. Exhibitor's may elect to show in all of the optional classes listed for individual awards, however only the top 3 optional class scores will be counted in final placements.
5. Ties will be broken in the following manner:
  - Jr. Robinson Award – highest placement in the Grand Championship Under Saddle
  - Carson Masters – highest combined placement in Juvenile Trail Obstacle
  - General Jackson – highest placement in Trail Obstacle
  - Al Prewitt – highest placement in Trail Obstacle
  - James Powell – highest combined score including Grand Championship classes (conformation and all divisions)
6. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st-16; 2nd-14; 3rd-12; 4th-10; 5th-8; 6th-6; participation-2.
