Breeding and Foaling guidelines for the 2015-2016 season

1. What foals are eligible in 2016?

Any foal conceived in 2015 and born in 2016 is eligible as long as the foal is registered KMSHA/SMHA during 2016 and foals must have DNA on file that proves parentage. Eligibility means sired by a "Registered" as KMSHA/SMHA and "Certified to Breed" Sire and foaled by a Registered/Certified Mare. Registration of ownership must be up to date and on record with the KMSHA. DNA for both Sire and Dam must also be on file.

2. What are the requirements for 2015 breedings and 2016 foals?

Both Sire and Dam must be considered "Eligible" as stated above in 1.

Stallions must be KBIF nominated no later than July 30, 2016 with the KMSHA/SMHA. **The arrival and location in Kentucky of Stallions and Mares from out of state who plan to stand in Kentucky during the breeding season** must be documented by the Owner's Agent of record and reported to the KMSHA 45 days prior to breeding . This would include the address of the Agent standing the Stallion or Mare. (Proof of the stallion or mare breeding/AI collection in the state of Kentucky, "Kentucky Bred" must be listed on the official breeding certificate with affidavit attached and signed by the Agent or a licensed veterinarian.)

Stallions and mares permanently residing in Kentucky can be bred and reported as usual. (Proof of the stallion or mare breeding/AI collection in the state of Kentucky, "Kentucky Bred" must be listed on the official breeding certificate with affidavit attached and signed by the Owner, Agent or a licensed veterinarian.)

Registered and Certified Mares must be bred in Kentucky or can be AI'd out of state by an eligible stallion collected in Kentucky.

Inspections from the KBIF committee or the KTRC can be conducted without notice. (Violations of this provision could result in a KBIF lifetime ban.)

3. What are the foaling requirements for 2016?

All eligible Mares must foal in the state of Kentucky for 2015-2016 (no exceptions) **Out of State Mares must reside in the state of Kentucky 45 days prior to foaling.** All foals born in Kentucky must be certified by affidavit as "Born in Kentucky" by the Owner, Agent or a licensed veterinarian and record of such foaling must be submitted to the KMSHA prior to foal registration.

Violation of the 45 day provision or foaling in Kentucky foaling requirement will void KBIF eligibility for the foal. All affidavits are sworn testimony and are subject to perjury if falsified and could result in prosecution for providing false information to a government agency.
