Presentation of the KMSHA 20th Anniversary Junior Robinson Best in Show Awards Mares /Geldings Award and Stallions Award.

You Choose any 4 of the following Classes to be eligible for this award:

1. Age /Gender division preliminary class under saddle
2. Age /Gender division preliminary class conformation
3. Grand Championship Under Saddle Trail/Country Trail/Classic or Park
4. Grand Championship Conformation
5. Trail Obstacle
6. Western Pleasure

Points will be awarded as follows: 1st-12, 2nd-10, 3rd-8, 4th-6, 5th-4, participation-2. Highest total points for each Mares/Geldings and Stallions wins\*.

20th Anniversary Junior Robinson Award winners will receive the following prize money:

Mares/ Geldings;1st Place \$500, 2nd Place \$300, 3rd Place \$200.

Stallions;1st Place \$500, 2nd Place \$300, 3rd Place \$200.

The SMHA will have a "Best in Show Award". The single spotted horse with the most accumulated points in any combination of classes will receive \$200.\*

Points awarded as follows: 1st-12, 2nd-10, 3rd-8, 4th-6, 5th-4, participation-2.

\*Judges decision final and based upon combination Best Image and Points.

\*\*\* Juvenile may never have won a blue ribbon. Show at the walk and favorite gait.

## General Information Both Days

Classes designated as KMSHA/SMHA Open classes are open to those horses of any sex, relative age, registered with the Kentucky Mountain Saddle Horse Association and Spotted Mountain Horse Association and to any riders, other than juveniles, except in the case of a juvenile who has declared himself/herself an adult rider as defined in the rulebook. Classes designated as SMHA are open only to those horses registered with the SMHA.

Current Negative Coggins and Health Certificate are required for each horse brought to the show grounds. Individuals on federal or certified HIO suspension/disqualifications may not transport horses to the grounds and may not participate in the show in any way, except as a spectator. All individuals who desire to participate in the show must be members in "Good Standing" with the KMSHA.

Championship Classes: In order to compete in a Championship class, a horse must have shown and completed a qualifying class in a division relative to the Championship class.

Entry Fee Regular Classes: \$30.00/Class Paybacks: \$35, 20, 15, 5, R

Inspection Fee: \$5.00 per horse per day

Grand Championship Classes: \$55/Class Paybacks: \$500, 150, 75, 25, R

Stalls: \$85.00 for weekend, Thursday-Saturday. Any exhibitor not shipped out

by 8am Sunday will be charged \$35.00 per stall. For stall reservations please

call the KMSHA @ 502-863-3545. The daily rate for stalls is \$35.00 per horse. Any horse

showing out of a trailer requires a \$20.00 per horse per day grounds fee. The Class is

considered to be complete when all the requirements of the class have been met and the Judge has turned in a signed card.
