THE JUNIOR HORSE SHOW is a fun show for young riders that are not ready to show yet. Show attire is not required but horse, rider and attendants should be neat and tidy (Please no ratty jeans or logo Tee shirts, lets make our kids proud)
Helmets are required for classes 29 and 31.

"FIRST SOLO" PRE-JUVENILE CLASS (ANY BREED HORSE/PONY) Front side of ring -straight a way- used only
This is a class for young solo riders who feel that they are above a lead line class but are not ready to show alone. Any horse or pony is okay, does not need to be gaited. Each rider should enter the ring and be accompanied by an adult who may help as needed (the adult does not lead the horse, the rider is in control). The rider enters the ring at a WALK, will be asked to reverse, WALK the other way of the ring and then will be called to the line up. The adult will stand by the rider and the Judge will address each rider.

Entry Fees:

Regular Classes \$30.00 + \$5.00 Daily DQP
Championship \$50

Paybacks:

Regular Classes \$50, \$40, \$20, R, R
Championship Classes \$100, \$75, \$50, R, R

Stalls: \$50 each Thur-Sun AM BYO Bedding

Show out of trailers: \$10 per horse per day

Entries and cancelations must be made 3 classes ahead.

Three or fewer entries- Result in paybacks that start with 2nd place money.
Show Management may choose to cancel any class with only one entry.

KMSHA/SMHA Open classes are open to horses of any sex or age registered with the Kentucky Mountain Saddle Horse Association and Spotted Mountain Horse Association and to any riders other than juvenile except in the case where the juvenile has been declared an adult rider as provided in the rulebook.

KMSHA classes are only open to those horses registered with the KMSHA.

SMHA classes are only open to those horses registered with the SMHA.

Championship Classes: To compete a horse must have been shown in a qualifying class in a division addressed by the Championship class.

Important Information: All horses on show grounds must have a current Coggins and Health Certificate. Persons on federal or certified HIO suspensions or disqualifications may not transport a horse to the show grounds and may not participate in the show in any way other than as a spectator. All individuals who desire to participate in KMSHA/SMHA classes must be a member in good standing as defined in the rulebook, possess a current Riders Card and be able to present documentation showing that their horse is registered and certified with the KMSHA/SMHA
