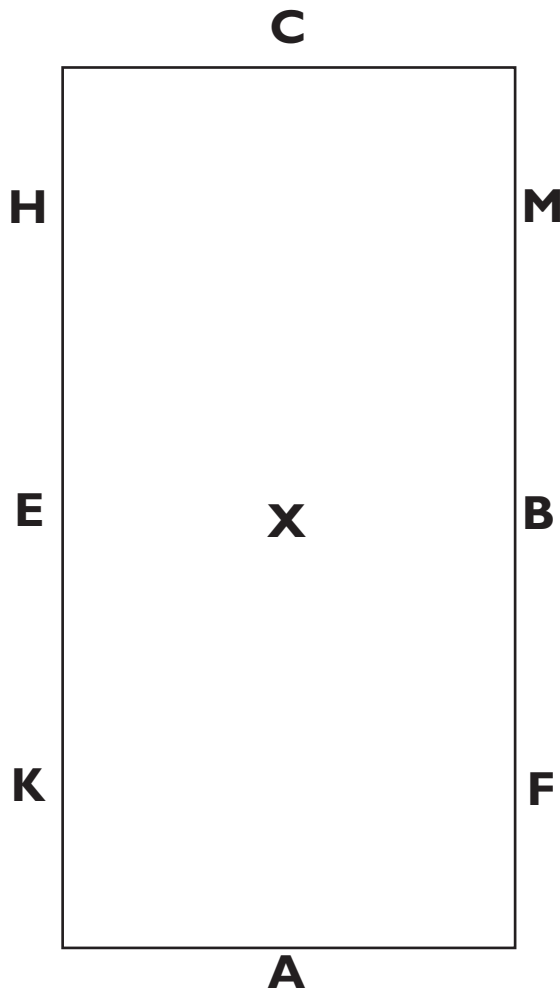

UNDERSTANDING THIS SCORE SHEET:

All elements of this test, as well as the collective marks section, carry a maximum weight of 10 points.

Some elements of the test are weighted because of the importance of the element to the test or the difficulty of a particular element. These elements have coefficients. Scores are obtained for these elements by taking the point score awarded and multiplying it by the assigned coefficient to arrive at a final score. [i.e. a score of 6 multiplied by the coefficient of 2 equals a final score of 12 for an element.]

Errors in executing an element are deducted at the rate of 1 point. Failure to execute any portion of an element results in an automatic deduction of 7 points.

Placings are determined by adding the total number of points the rider has obtained, subtracting any errors from that total, and converting the total number of points to a percentage of the maximum points possible for the test. Places are awarded based on a comparison of the percentages obtained by all riders in the group.

ABOUT THE ARENA: The judge stands behind letter C. Riders enter and exit at letter A. The arena should be 50 feet wide and 80 feet long, however, if space does not permit, the arena is shortened by 10 feet on a side, but never smaller than 30 feet wide and 60 feet long. Placings in the arena should be marked by cones with clearly visible letters. No center line letters are marked. Letters B and E are always at the midpoint of the long sides.
